



The Carolina International looks forward to a great weekend of competition starting on March 24th. The FEI and the USEF have provided us with specific protocols for managing biosecurity concerns related to EHV - 1 outbreaks. Please review the related health requirements below to ensure you are prepared for check in **upon your arrival**. We wish you a safe and successful weekend.

- All FEI horses must be stabled on grounds.
- Any horses competing in a USEF/USEA National Level traveling and stabling with FEI horses, including non-competing horses, must all be registered on the FEI Horse App. Please see the link below to obtain FEI horse registration and contact Sharyn Antico at sharynantico@gmail.com no later than Friday March 18th to ensure you have secured appropriate stabling. Otherwise, National horses will need to be stabled in separate barns. **No FEI horses or National horses traveling and stabling together will be allowed into stabling until temperatures have been taken, approved by the official veterinary team and recorded.**

- **All** FEI and National horses are required to arrive at the Carolina Horse Park with a Veterinarian Health Certificate within 72 hours of arrival. This includes ship-in horses as well.
- All FEI and National Horses traveling and stabling together must record temperatures twice daily, beginning three days prior to arriving at the competition grounds. These temperature readings must be entered into the FEI Horse App.
- All FEI and National Horses traveling and stabling together must take twice daily temperature readings and enter them into the FEI Horse App. In addition, you must have your horse health self-certification forms completed in the FEI Horse App prior to your arrival at the competition grounds.
- **Our veterinary team will ONLY be accepting arrivals on:**

Tuesday 3/22 12 Noon - 5PM

Wednesday 3/23 9 AM - 12 Noon and 1 PM - 5 PM

Thursday 3/24 9 AM - 12 Noon

***Due to unforeseen circumstances, if your arrival time is outside of the schedule above, please contact our Stable Manager, Vicki Reynolds, at 910.215.7087. Your horse will be placed in an isolation stall until our veterinarians can check you in during the above scheduled timeframes.**

All horses must enter the Carolina Horse Park at Gate 8 on 3603 Calloway Rd.

- Please bring your own personal thermometers for arrival and daily temperature taking.
- Please note these governing body requirements are subject to change and we ask that you consistently check the FEI and USEF websites for ongoing updates.
